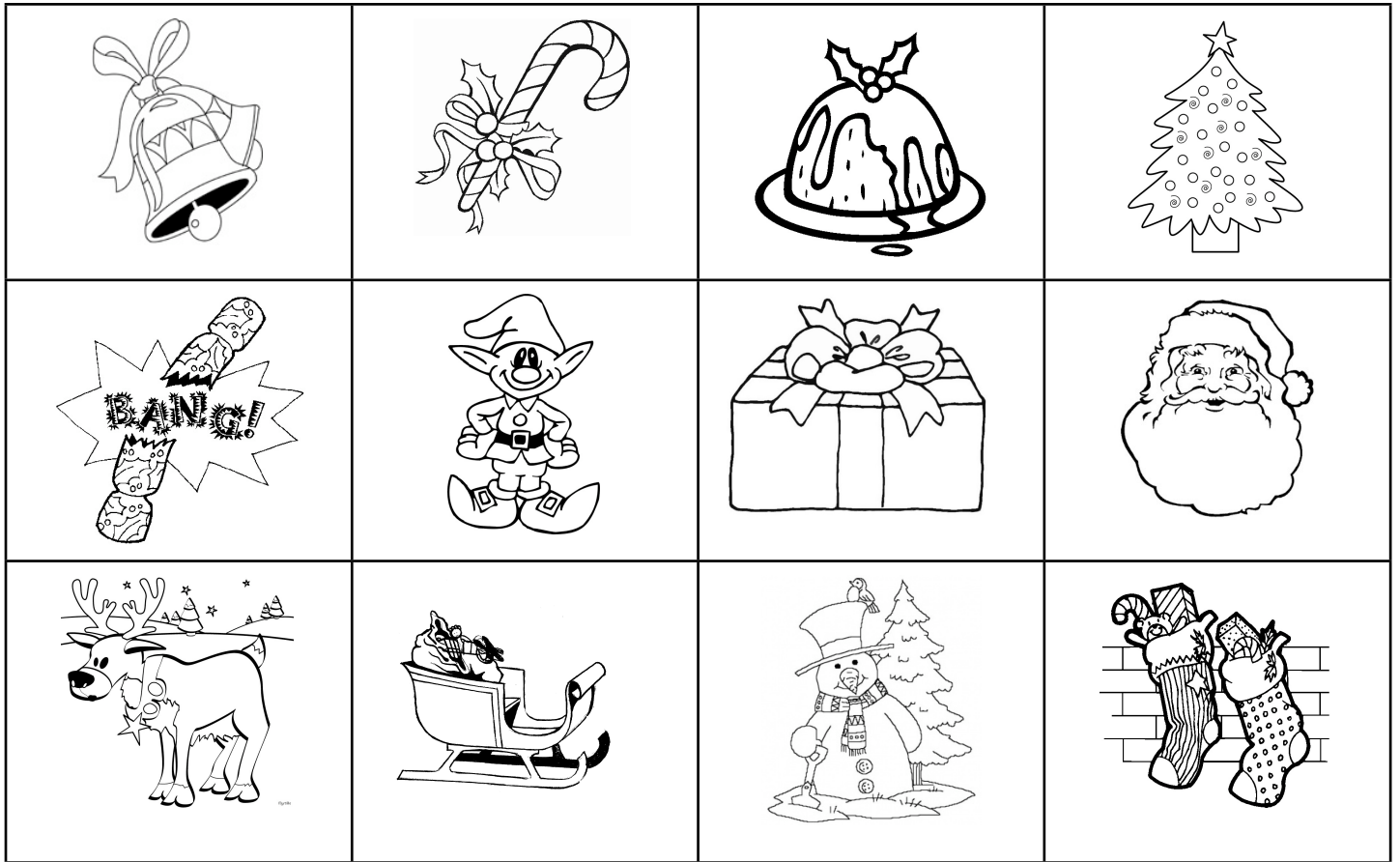
DÉROULEMENT
